Minor Requirements

The minor in religion can be used for different educational goals, including enhancement of a course of study in another discipline and/or personal enrichment.

The requirements for a **minor in religion** are 20 credits.

Religion minors are encouraged to work with a religion faculty advisor to choose courses that support an emphasis (see above) based on their particular interests. Students should normally declare a minor by the end of the junior year. Students may apply to transfer the equivalent of two courses and no more than 8 credits from outside the college.
