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## Major Requirements

The requirements for a **major in German** are 32 credits:

Students may take one 4-credit German course in English.

Students studying abroad for one year must take GER 450 Study Abroad Experience and Reflection.

**Students seeking licensure to teach German** must also take GER 330 Introduction to German Literature and Film and GER 332 German Grammar and Phonetics and fulfill the requirements for a major in education (<https://catalog.concordiacollege.edu/arts-sciences/education/education-major/>). For additional information about teaching German, see the chair of world languages and cultures or the chair of education.

**K-8 World Language and Culture Endorsement License:** Students majoring in elementary education have the option of completing an add-on endorsement (<https://catalog.concordiacollege.edu/arts-sciences/education/#endorsementoptionstext>) in one of the five world languages. Each add-on endorsement program prepares students to be recommended for licensure in that world language in grades K-8. Each add-on endorsement requires a separate application for licensure. All students must attain the intermediate-high level of oral proficiency.
